[3] Support

This workshop is supported by a RIMS Project and a Topology Project. We are going to get some support to cover the local expenses for foreign participants. In principle, the local expenses mean the hotel fee in Kyoto, up to 6 days and 5 nights (25th Nov - 30th Nov), and the local travelling fee between Kansai Airport (Osaka) and Kyoto Station.

[4] How to get to Kyoto

There is a special express train, Haruka, from Kansai Airport to Kyoto Station. It takes 75 minutes, and the fee is about 3,500 yen. The flight from Sydney is expected to arrive at Kansai around 19:20. The time table of Haruka after 19:30 is as follows:

So after your arrival at the Kansai Airport, you have several options to go to Kyoto on the same day.

When you decide your trip schedule to Kyoto, please let us know as soon as possible (hopefully by the end of July), if you want us to book a hotel for you. The period of our conference is a very busy one, a lot of tourists visit Kyoto in this season, so finding a good accommodation is not easy, expecially after July.
